#### Officials Needed

Congratulations to Freya Webb on gaining her Level 1 Field Official's Licence.

Spring has sprung and we're looking forward to a great summer of track and field competition so it's time for me to issue my annual plea for help with officiating.

For each league meeting, every club must provide one timekeeper, one track judge and five field judges. Without them events, and even whole matches, could be cancelled. Therefore points are awarded for providing officials and deducted for failing to provide them. With around 20 matches across the various leagues, lots of help is needed and qualified club officials are in short supply. One way in which the YDL is addressing the problem this season is to award 8 match points for each fully qualified official but only 4 points for each unqualified volunteer. As SSHAC does not have enough qualified officials we will be at a disadvantage, however good our athletes are.

We desperately need more people to train and qualify as Technical Officials in all disciplines – Track, Field, Timekeeper, Starter/Starter's Assistant. This requires commitment but is very rewarding. Now is the ideal time to attend a course in readiness for the start of the season. If you think it might interest you, a relative, or friend, please get in touch and have a chat with me or one of our other qualified officials to find out what's involved. We're a friendly lot and would love to have you on our team.

### **Throws Cage News**

We are happy to report that work on the throws cage is underway to bring it up to the new UKA specification. The circle has been concreted and extensions will be fitted to the gates. The wheels will run on the existing concrete arcs but there will be new, colour-coded, locations for the pins to ensure they can be locked in the correct positions for discus and for right- and left-handed hammer throwers. New nets and ropes will be fitted. This work is on schedule to be completed by the end of March so we should be able to resume discus and hammer training from the beginning of April. It also enables us to host league fixtures at home.

We have been instructed by the contractor that the extended gates and new netting will mean that gate nets should be raised for use and lowered at the end of a session, but have been assured this will be an easy operation.
